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What is the Erasmus Program?

Within the framework of Erasmus Student Mobility Program, Istanbul Gedik University offers associate degree, undergraduate and graduate students the opportunity to become an exchange student in any European country for one semester or one year and to receive financial support for their stay abroad within the program. Financially supported internship opportunity is the other mobility type in the program, provided that it is at least two months in order to increase manners.

What is not the Erasmus Program?

Erasmus Program is not a "foreign language learning program".

Erasmus Program is not exactly a "scholarship" program. However, the financial contribution of the selected students can vary depending on the country of destination.

Erasmus Program is not a "diploma" or "research" program.

Aims of the Erasmus Program

The aim of the Erasmus Program is to increase the quality of higher education in Europe and to encourage innovation in universities. This goal can be summarized as presenting the best practices in different European countries to the benefit of the whole of Europe. Erasmus program, its stated objectives; It strives to achieve mutual exchange of students and educators in Europe by encouraging international cooperation between universities.

With the Erasmus Program, students gain a different experience abroad. This experience includes getting to know other cultures as well as

introducing your own culture to foreign students. Erasmus also offers students from other European countries the opportunity to teach in a multicultural environment and to make new friends from every country in Europe. As the participating students have the opportunity to study in a different faculty with a completely different system, they can see the pros and cons of their faculties and make requests for a more efficient and quality education system. Thus, universities gain an international experience and reputation and can increase the quality of education through self-renewal / development.

Operation of Erasmus Program

Erasmus Learning Mobility can be done within the scope of bilateral agreements between universities. In order to benefit from Learning Mobility, students must apply to Erasmus Coordinators and participate in the selection process.

Courses to be taken by students who are entitled to study abroad with the Erasmus Program, residence opportunities, semester start dates, etc. varies according to the university to be attended.

The courses and grades taken by the students returning after the Erasmus exchange will be recorded in their transcripts after being evaluated by the faculty coordinators and approved by the dean's office. If the course selection is made correctly, Erasmus students do not lose a semester in any way. It is guaranteed by the university that the courses taken abroad will be recognized academically at Istanbul Gedik University.

A student can only benefit from the Erasmus study mobility activity once during his / her higher education life; Benefiting from the internship mobility activity does not prevent the benefit from learning mobility.

Erasmus + Study Mobility (ERASMUS + KA 103)

It means that associate / undergraduate / graduate / doctorate students registered at our university spend part of their education in one of the higher education institutions abroad, in which our university is a partner, with a bilateral agreement.

Erasmus + Internship Mobility (ERASMUS + KA 103)

It means that the student registered at our university has an internship abroad in order to gain practical work experience in the field of vocational education.

Learning Mobility with Erasmus + Partner Countries (ERASMUS + KA 107)

Student mobility with Partner Countries can take place as learning activities; internship activity is excluded. Our university continues its activities within the scope of the project written by our Coordinator in the 2019-2020 academic year, and the project provides education opportunities for our students from the country.
