For the students who will attend the English Preparatory Program, the English Placement Exam will be held **face to face**, at Block B-Conference Hall at Kartal Campus of Istanbul Gedik University, by taking all the security measures regarding the pandemic. HES code is checked at the entrance to the university. Be at the exam venue by making the necessary preparations before the exam.

PREPARATORY STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ATTEND THIS EXAM WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE COUNTED AS A1/A2 LEVEL AND NO LEVEL CHANGES WILL BE MADE WITHIN THE YEAR.

## **Exam Flow:**

- 1. All students enter the first stage. The first stage lasts 60 minutes: 10:00-11:00.
- 2. Exams are read and the list of students who are eligible to enter the second stage is announced before 12:00.
- 3. The students whose names are mentioned in the list enter the second stage, which will start at 12:00. The second stage is 60 minutes.
- 4. Students who do not need to enter the second stage are placed in the appropriate level according to their scores. They can learn their levels/classes in the Orientation Program.

## **General Information About the Exam:**

- Written exam duration is 60 minutes each.
- The exam consists of two parts. The students who need the second stage are announced by the lecturers.

- Students must bring pencil, eraser and sharpener.
- Students must have **both a pen and a pencil** at the time of the exam.

## **Exam Rules:**

- 1. Lecture notes, books and other materials are collected at the place designated by the invigilator.
- 2. Invigilators arrange students to sit properly, check their identities, and ensure that students sign the attendance list.
- 3. Invigilators explain that the IDs of the students taking the exam must be on the desk during the exam.
- 4. It is forbidden for students to have devices such as mobile phones, headphones, pocket computers, Bluetooth, voice recorders or smart watches with them during the exam. If there are such devices, it is ensured that they are kept turned off in a place where he or she cannot reach them, in accordance with the exam rules.
- 5. It is forbidden for students who have finished the exam to wait in the corridor, enter other exam halls, and speak or signal with the students who are still taking the exam.
