#### 5. Fees & Expenses

Insurance fee	Students are required to join the National Health Insurance scheme from 2021. Fees per month are approximately KRW 90,000 per month(subject to change).

Buddy Program (1:1 Mentoring)	Exchange students are provided with 1:1 Mentoring(Buddy)  Program within 2~3 weeks after the start date of the semster.  Purpose of buddy program is to help the new students get used to the campus life in Korea and interact with Korean students to exchange and experience new culture. One Korean student would be paired with one international student.
